- Google talk dropped an advertisement for Beauty and the Beast film in Google Home and Google Assistant. This is similar to Amazon's Alexa and Google response was "This isn't an ad; the beauty in the Assistant is that it invites our partners to be our guest and share their tales." Backlash was swift and Google responded quickly with "We're continuing to experiment with new ways to surface unique content for users and we could have done better in this case."
- US Army gets world's largest laser weapon system. A 58kW laser beam has been
  developed earlier this year. "We have shown that a powerful directed energy laser is
  now sufficiently light-weight, low volume and reliable enough to be deployed on
  tactical vehicles for defensive applications on land, at seas and in the air..." stated
  Robert Afzal, senior fellow for Lockheed's Laser and Sensor Systems.

- In 2015, a 27-year-old Daniel Boria tied over 100 helium balloons to a lawn chair and floated 2.5 miles above Calgary getting in the way of commercial aircraft and putting 100s lives at risk. Boria was ordered to pay \$26,500 CAN [\$18,822 USD] in fines when he was sentenced last Friday. The judge agreed that most of the fines should be donated to a charity of Boria's choice and Boria "said the stunt was worthwhile and he has no regrets."
- Researchers at Oxford believe they've invented an AI system that can lip-read better than humans. They trained it on 1,000s of hours of BBC News in collaboration with Google's DeepMind AI division. The system now recognizes 17,500 words and will keep learning as it watches TV.
- Netflix is replacing star ratings with Thumbs Up and Thumbs Down. This is because
  people are 200% more likely to rate a video if they just have to give a thumbs
  up/thumbs down than a star rating. They will also be introducing a new
  percent-match feature that shows how good of a match any given show or movie is
  for an individual subscriber.
- Nintendo Switch shipped with unpatched 6-month-old webkit vulnerability. This is located in the browser engine so just be sure you're browsing only safe websites to minimize the potential threat vectors or just not browse at all till Nintendo patches this which is the best idea.
- "Project Scorpio" gaming console will feature an internal power supply unit similar to the Xbox One S and a 4K game DVR and streaming at 60 FPS.
