- WanaDecrypt0r ransomware only earns \$26k in payments based on the bitcoin wallet. Probably causing most likely massive financial damage. This is a new version of WannaCry ransomware that doesn't have a kill switch.

- Google's OSS-Fuzz program has found over 1,000 bugs in 47 open source projects. Of those 264 potential security vulnerabilities: 7 in Wireshark, 33 in LibreOffice, 8 in SQLite 3 and 17 in FFmpeg and more.
- Google Maps now uses Street View to show you exactly where to make turns. You can now look at your phone while driving to confirm that the place you need to turn looks like the place you need to turn.
- Tesla's solar roofs go up for pre-order this week. Supposedly the roof tiles would be able to pay for themselves over electricity cost savings as they are warranted for life.
