 - WoW Developer AMA

- PSA: A new flaw has been discovered that impacts Intel 6th and 7th Generation Skylake and Kaby Lake-based processors that support HyperThreading. The issue can cause unpredictable system behavior, including crashes and potential data loss. So look for an upcoming update and patch.
- State Legislators in Rhode Island want to expand the surveillance in their state to catch uninsured drivers via license plate readers.
