- Slashdot: Researchers published in the journal Social Cognitive and Affective Neuroscience the results of two experiments conducted involving more than 200 college students that concluded that acetaminophen can reduce a person's capacity to empathize with another person's pain.
- New fidget spinners which are bluetooth-enabled are catching fire due to poor quality electronic circuits.
- Japan wants to put a man on the moon accelerating Asian space race. It'll probably be part of an international mission.
- New study finds how much sleep Fitbit users really get. Average Fitbit user is in bed for 7 hours and 33 minutes but only gets 6 hours and 38 minutes of sleep. Women get about 25 minutes more sleep on average each night compared to men. It was also found that men get slightly higher percentages of deep sleep than women until about the age of 55. Women win when it comes to REM logging an average of 10 minutes more per night than men.
- Elon Musk's boring machine completes the first section of an LA tunnel. This tunnel will eventually run from LAX to Culver City, Santa Monica, Westwood and Sherman Oaks. Godot, the Samuel Beckett-inspired name of the boring machine is working on the LAX to Culver City route currently.
- After surveying 2.5 million dogs and 500,000 cats in the U.S. last year, a group of researchers found that about 1 in 3 were overweight or obese. Research over the last decade shows a 169% increase in cats and a 158% increase in dogs.
- Researchers at NUS (National University of Singapore) have created a probiotic sour beer that may boost immunity and improve gut health. This bacteria is able to neutralize toxins and viruses and regulate the immune system. That's something I'd drink to.
